

The NYS Historic Newspapers project provides free online access to dozens of newspaper archives to help in your search. The Library Archivist can help you in your research.

### Get Tech

**T**he Library has a number of computers available for public use, including several specified for children or teens. Wireless service is available 24/7.

To use the computers, you should have a library card in good standing, although one-time passes can be issued for guests with photo ID—ask at the main desk.

You are guaranteed one hour of computer use per day. If the computers are in high demand, you may be asked to sign off after an hour so that another person can use the machine.

In order to save your work, please bring a USB drive with you, as files cannot be saved to the hard drive.

You can also print your work. The first 5 pages of resumes, school work, and job applications are free. Otherwise, printing fees are:

- \$0.15 per page black and white
- \$0.50 per page color

Library staff can provide limited assistance. If you need help using a computer or specific program, check out the schedule of training sessions on the library web site.
